In the last couple of years, Tualatin Hills Park & Recreation District has become aware of the valuable need to recycle paper products, plastics and metals to help towards supporting our environment. Not only by the means of recycling of the material but utilizing the recycled products as well.

We are always looking at stretching the dollar towards purchasing things that will last for many years, as well as hold up to wear and tear and vandalism.

In the last couple of years we purchased some recycled plastic 4X4 sign posts from Wishbone Industries; knowing that they had a lifetime guarantee on their posts, we decided to try them out.

They produced a slotted custom signpost (much like a bollard) to replace the old pressure-treated wooden 4X4's that we used to use. By using these recycled plastic posts we have found that latex paint bonds well to them and vandalism has been somewhat reduced due to the density of the material which is a plus.

We are also very pleased with the quality of workmanship of Wishbone Industries at manufacturing these custom made posts to our specifications. I think they have great products to offer and are certainly a great Company to work with to meet our needs.
